Requirements: An ISU Advanced Novice Pairs Short Program, maximum duration of 2:20 mins +/-10 sec to music of the skater's own choice comprising the following elements (skated in any order).

One (1) lift from Groups 1 to 4, one arm holds are not allowed			
One (1) Twist lift (single or double)			
One (1) Solo Jump (double)			
Solo Spin Combination no change foot (min (6) revs in total)			
One (1) Death Spiral			
One (1) Step sequence fully utilisation of the ice surface			
Program Components Comments – <u>Composition, Presentation and Skating Skills</u> to be evaluated			

Repeats: A maximum of two repeats are permitted at the judges' discretion without music. The element(s) to be repeated must be from the elements already executed, either one element twice or two elements once each. No substitutions of elements are permitted from those already executed.

Pass Mark: The assessment will take into consideration the Grade of Execution of the elements and the program components in determining a Pass or Fail. Tests will be assessed in accordance with the latest ISU Communication Guidelines for marking Grade of Execution.

A Pass cannot be awarded if more than one element has a GOE of -5 or more than two elements have a GOE of -3 or less.
