# 1 Purpose of the Policy

This Policy encompasses ordering guidelines for athletes' uniform for Australian Representatives.

#### 2 Application of Policy

This policy applies to all eligible Australian Singles, Pairs, Ice Dance and Synchronized skating athletes in Basic Novice, Basic Novice A, Basic Novice B, Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior.

#### 3 Policy Statement

# 3.1 Ordering of Uniforms

- All Australian athletes nominated to represent ISA at an ISU sanctioned event, will be required to comply and attain the required uniform as stated in this policy.
- All orders will be processed immediately after athletes have been informed of their nominations.
- Athletes must place their orders online through the ISA website and an invoice will be made available to the athlete for payment of their order.

# 3.2 <u>Advertising/Sponsorship on Representative Uniform</u>

- Personal sponsorship may be included on Australian Representative uniforms.
- Individuals may include personal sponsorship on other items of clothing, subject to approval by the ISA Board, but must adhere to the following:
  - a) Request approval for, and advise ISA BOM of the details of the personal sponsorship, prior to signing and accepting any personal sponsorship, scholarship, funding, unless provided by ISA, an ISA Member or an affiliated Club and the proposed media to be displayed on the items of apparel
  - b) Agree to adhere to ISU Rule 102, paragraph 6, and ISU Communication in relation to uniform and sponsorship.

#### 3.3 Use of Representative Uniform

- The designated ISA Representative Uniform is the only official jacket for international events and must be taken to each international event.
- No additional embroidery, logos or badges are to be placed on the ISA Uniform, except as provided below section 3.5 and 3.6.
- Under no circumstances should the ISA Jacket be traded or sold to anyone.

# 3.4 Types of Uniforms

### 3.4.1 Championship Representative

- Uniform for athletes and their main coach who have been selected by Ice Skating Australia to represent Australia at ISU Championship Events in Junior or Senior (Singles, Pairs, Ice Dance, Synchronized) as listed on the ISU Calendar
  - ISU Junior Grand Prix of Figure Skating
  - ISU Grand Prix of Figure Skating
  - ISU Four Continents Figure Skating Championships
  - · ISU World Junior Figure Skating Championships
  - ISU World Figure Skating Championships
  - ISU World Synchronized Skating Championships
  - ISU World Junior Synchronized Skating Championships
  - ISU Synchronized Skating Junior World Challenge Cup
- Uniform for Team Leaders who have been selected to represent Australia at ISU Championship Events

# 3.4.2 <u>Australian Representative</u>

- Uniform for athletes and their main coach who have been selected by Ice Skating Australia to represent Australia at international competitions in Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Advanced Novice, Junior or Senior (Singles, Pairs, Ice Dance) as listed on the ISU Calendar
- Uniform for Team Leaders who have been selected to represent Australia at International Events

### 3.4.3 <u>Team AUS Range (Boxing Kangaroo/ Figure Skating Training Apparel)</u>

- Uniform for athletes and their main coach who have been selected by Ice Skating Australia to represent Australia at international competitions in Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Advanced Novice, Junior or Senior (Singles, Pairs, Ice Dance) as listed on the ISU Calendar
- Uniform for Team Leaders who have been selected to represent Australia at International Event

#### 3.4.4 Australian Synchronized Representative

- Uniform for athletes and their main coach who have been selected by Ice Skating Australia to represent Australia at an international competition in Basic Novice, Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior as listed on the ISU Calendar.
- Uniform for Team Leaders who have been selected to represent Australia at ISU Synchronized Events

#### 3.4.5 MEMBERS Jacket

- Uniform for athletes who are part of the National Squad Jacket
- Uniform for athletes and their main coach competing in ISU Adult Competitions or Adult Competitions sanctioned by an ISU member
- Uniform for athletes and their main coach competing in Competitions sanctioned by an ISU member
- Athletes or team for international competitions, ISU development seminars and/or camps.
- Supporters travelling with athletes or team for international competitions, ISU development seminars and/or camps.
- Members of State Associations with affiliation to Ice Skating Australia Incorporated

# 3.4.6 Merchandise Range

- Merchandise for athletes who are part of the National Squad Jacket
- Merchandise for athletes and their main coach competing in ISU Adult Competitions or Adult Competitions sanctioned by an ISU member
- Merchandise for athletes and their main coach competing in Competitions sanctioned by an ISU member
- Athletes or team for international competitions, ISU development seminars and/or camps.
- Supporters travelling with athletes or team for international competitions, ISU development seminars and/or camps.
- Members of State Associations with affiliation to Ice Skating Australia Incorporated

#### 3.5 Addition of Name

- The first name of the athlete/ coach/ or applicant can be added to the jacket by the athlete after receiving the jacket
- Refer to the ISA Uniform Style Guidelines for more information regarding size and placement of name embroidery
- All additions must comply with the Ice Skating Australia Style Guidelines

#### 3.6 <u>Use of Logos on other items</u>

Individuals and/or teams must not wear or use the ISA Logo or ISA Uniform Logos on other

- items of clothing without written permission from ISA.
- Individuals and/or teams must not use the Australian Coat of Arms on other items of clothing without written permission from ISA.
- Individuals must not add or decorate the Ice Skating Australia uniform without written permission from ISA.
- Non-compliance by any individual may result in the removal of uniform items, and removal of nomination of the athletes to international events.
