Current Australian Skating Season	Commences 1st February 2017 and concludes 31st January 2018
Current International Skating Season	Commences 1st July 2017 and concludes 30th June 2018
Eligible	Age Eligibility ISU Rule 108 (as per age limits before July 1 <sup>st</sup> preceding the event.) and meet all ISU and ISA citizenship and residency requirements to be able to represent Australia.

ISA International Pool	Athletes who achieved the ISA International Benchmark are included in the ISA International Pool according to ISA Policy ISA-10
ISU Minimum Technical Scores	The minimum Technical Element Scores for Short Program/Dance and Free Skating/Dance as determined and published by the ISU. Note: These scores must be achieved at least 21 days prior to the Championship Event in the current season (2015/2016) or the preceding season (2014/2015) and can be achieved at the same or at different events.
Previous International Skating Season	The ISU Skating Season that commenced on the 1 <sup>st</sup> July 201 <u>5</u> and concluded on the 31 <sup>st</sup> May 201 <u>6</u>
