

**BASIC NOVICE TECHNICAL TEST**

Number of Judges Required: Two (2), or One (1) National Senior Test Judge

**Requirements:** A free skating program of 2 minutes 30 seconds duration (+/- 10 seconds) for Basic Novice age eligible skaters or 3 minutes 00 seconds duration (+/- 10 seconds) for Intermediate Novice and Intermediate age eligible skaters, to music of the skater's own choice comprising the following elements (skated in any order).

Element	Comments	Repeats	GOE
Minimum of 4 jump elements. Basic Novice : Maximum of 4 Jumps Intermediate Novice / Intermediate Ladies: Maximum 5 Jumps <b>Single Axel Jump - mandatory</b> <b>Double Jump - mandatory</b> There may be up to 2 jump combinations or sequences. Jump combinations can contain only 2 jumps, a jump sequence can contain any number of jumps.			
Maximum of two spins of a different nature (abbreviation) One of which must be a spin combination with change of foot (min 8 revs) or without change of foot (min 6 rev), May commence with a fly. One spin with no change of position can be executed with a change of foot (min 8 revs) or without change of foot (min 6 rev), May commence with a fly.			
One (1) Step Sequence <u>fully</u> utilising the ice surface.			

**Program Components Comments – For Basic Novice Skating Skills and Performance to be evaluated**  
**For Intermediate Novice/Intermediate Skating Skills, Interpretation and Performance to be evaluated**

**Jumps:** No jump is to receive the equivalent of a downgrade from the intended number of revolutions.

**Repeat:** A maximum of two repeats are permitted at the judges discretion without music. The element(s) to be repeated must be from the elements already executed, either one element twice or two elements once each. No substitutions of elements are permitted from those already executed.

**Pass Mark:** The assessment will take into consideration the Grade of Execution of the elements and the program components in determining a Pass or Fail. A Pass cannot be awarded if any element has a GOE of -5. The test is evaluated as a whole as either a Pass or a Fail. Tests will be conducted in accordance with the latest ISU Communication Guidelines for marking Grade of Execution.
