



IJS Competition Setup

All competition organisers are advised to ensure that they have setup their computer systems with the latest version of the IJS.

Along with the software from Swiss Timing, event organisers are advised that they must ensure that they have installed and loaded the following files onto their computer systems to cater for the non-ISU events, these files are available for download from the ISA website, <http://www.isa.org.au/technical>

In the C:\ISUCALCFS directory, the following files need to be placed in this directory

Segment_Setup.XML

ISUCalcFS_Setup.XML

The following file needs to be imported into your database; this contains the lower level non-ISU dance elements

ISA_Dance.XML

To ensure that the correct program component factors and verification rules are used for events, organisers are advised to ensure that the following selections are made when setting up the database for competitions.
