Nomination and Induction Protocol

Induction to the ISA *Hall of Fame* will be considered on a person by person basis. ISA Awards Committee will present their recommendations to the ISA Board for approval. Only candidates who have met the Selection Criteria will be considered.

Recognition will be given to those who have made a significant contribution in any field directly related to figure skating as indicated below:

- Athletes
- Officials
- Coaches
- Administrators

Nomination of Inductees

Nominations are to be submitted on the official online form by October 1st each year. Late nominations may be received after this date at the committee's discretion.

Nominations must be made on the nomination form found on the ISA Hall of Fame web page. Nominators may seek the assistance of their relevant state body to assist where required.

If not already advised, the ISA Awards Committee will advise the relevant state body of the nomination and seek their confirmation to second the nomination.

The ISA Awards Committee will seek additional information from the nominator if required.

1 Eligibility for Selection

In order to be selected as a member of the Australian Figure Skating Hall of Fame, each candidate must:

1. have achieved and contributed at the highest level to Figure Skating in Australia
2. no longer be participating in the role for which they are nominated
3. have upheld the ISU code of conduct and not engaged at any time in conduct which has brought or would be likely to bring Figure Skating into disrepute or censure
4. The nominee does not need to be a member of a State or Club at the time of being nominated

2 Selection

The ISA Awards Committee will:

1. Determine whether applicants have met the requirements of this Selection Criteria.
2. Submit their recommendations on all nominations to the ISA Board by November 1st each year.
3. The ISA board will at the next meeting of that month, finalise the list of inductees and advise them personally with an invitation to attend the final AFSC banquet.

3 Induction

1. Induction to the ISA Hall of Fame will take place at the final banquet of the Australian Figure Skating Championships in the year of nomination.
2. The inductee(s) will receive a formal invitation to attend the AFSC banquet as guests of the ISA Board.
3. The inductee's name will be added to the Hall of Fame, found on the ISA website. The community will also receive communications to celebrate the Hall of Fame inductee(s).
