### 1. INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF THE POLICY

- 1.1 The ISA International Pool is a list of ISA athletes who are eligible for selection to compete at ISU International events in the 2023/2024 season.
- 1.2 This policy applies to all age eligible ISA athletes in the Junior and Senior categories in the following disciplines: Single, Pair Skating, and Ice Dance.
- 1.3 The policy outlines the criteria required for ISA Junior and Senior athletes to be placed in the ISA International Junior and/or Senior Pools.

### 2. POLICY STATEMENT INCLUDING TECHNICAL ELEMENT SCORE (TES)

- 2.1 All ISU age eligible Junior and Senior athletes will be included in the ISA International Pool for the nominated category and discipline as follows:

Athletes who have achieved the required ISA international TES as listed in Table 1.

- 2.2 The ISA international TES (SP/RD and FS/FD) can be achieved in either the same or different ISA Champ Series events and/or ISU International events.
- 2.3 Athletes in the Junior category who achieved the required ISA international Junior TES (SP/RD and FS/FD) at ISA Champ Series events and/or ISU International Junior events in either 2022/2023 and/or 2023/2024 seasons will be placed in the ISA International Junior Pool for selection to ISU Junior events.
- 2.4 Athletes in the Senior category who achieved the required ISA international Senior TES (SP/RD and FS/FD) at ISA Champ Series events in either 2022/2023 and/or 2023/2024 ISU International Senior events will be placed in the ISA International Senior Pool for selection to ISU Senior events.
- 2.5 An athlete returning to compete at ISU International events following a medical issue such as illness or injury will need to complete the ISA Medical Clearance and appropriate reviews.
- 2.6 Athletes who provide notification of retirement, or a partnership split in Pair Skating or Ice Dance will be removed from the ISA International Pool.
