1 Purpose of the Policy

This policy outlines the guidelines for a one off per season special circumstances nomination to an International Event.

2 Application of Policy

This policy applies to all eligible Australian Singles, Pairs & Ice Dance athletes competing at Basic Novice through to Senior where they wish to be nominated for an international event and have not achieved the ISA International Qualifying Score/s at a Champ Series or International Event for their required division.

3 Policy Statement

Where an athlete wishes to enter an international event, and the athlete has achieved a combined FS/FD & SP/PD/RD that when totalled, is 90% or greater of the required Total combined FS/FD & SP/PD/RD ISA International Qualifying TES score/s as published by ISA, then ISA will consider nominating the athlete on a one off basis to an international event.

4 Applicable Conditions and Circumstances

* The athlete needs to request the entry from ISA and provide the supporting scores/event name where earned for their eligibility for nomination under this communication.

* ISA will nominate the athlete/s on a one off basis for their selected event – maximum 1 event per ISU International season.

* The athlete will not be placed in the ISA International Pool for that division until they earn the ISA International Qualifying Scores in each of FS/FD & SP/PD/RD in that division at a Champ Series or International Event.

* The TES scores in FS/FD or SP/PD/RD may be earned at different Champ Series or International Events during the 2022/2023 and/or 2023/2024 seasons.

* ISA will only nominate the athlete to an event if there are positions available for athletes to be nominated, and will rank for selection athletes in order of ISA seasons ranking. Some international events allow only one entry, and some events are unlimited (eg: Oceania and Hollins International). ISA will nominate the highest ranked in front of the special circumstances nomination entries if there is an entry limit.
