### ISA AFSC Qualification Scores 2024 Singles, Pair Skating & Ice Dance (including Adults)

(This communication replaces ISA Communication 144v2, 145 & 147)

#### 1. Purpose of the Communication

To advise qualifying Technical Elements Scores (TES) required for Australian Figure Skating Championship 2024 (AFSC) entry; Reserve selection process; ISA Member requirements submitting nominations and reserves list.

To advise ISA Board have decided to retain the Technical Element Scores from previous communications for AFSC 2024.

#### 2. Application of the Communication

All AFSC 2024 prospective participants/teams must achieve the minimum Technical Elements Score(s) as set out in this communication for their respective category in order for their ISA Member to nominate them to AFSC 2024.

The following minimum scores may be obtained at Champ Series events, ISA Member Championships, International events, or any event whereby the judging panel and technical panel have a minimum of **one (1) nationally qualified judge and one (1) nationally qualified technical specialist/controller** for the discipline and category.

Scores can only be earned between 1 February 2024 and prior to the close of AFSC 2024 entries OR earlier if your home state/territory has specific policies/timeline in relation to qualification/nomination for AFSC.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The scores listed in the following tables may change due to future ISU Communications regarding season elements, scale of values or technical element rule changes for the 2024/2025 season. If any scores are revised, prospective AFSC 2024 participants/teams will need to obtain the revised scores. If there are any changes, this communication will be updated.

#### 3. Communication Details

If there are two segments (SP/FS,RD/FD,PD/FD) in the category, it is possible to achieve the Minimum Technical Elements Score for each segment at different competitions. The minimum TES for Pattern Dance needs to be achieved in the same competition. The total element score is achieved by combining **both** pattern dance Technical Element Scores from the same competition.

Scores will be reviewed, revised and published for the start of the Australian competitive season in February.

ISA Members will be responsible for compliance with the tabulation of the scores and will not nominate athletes/teams who have not earned the score(s). For transparency, ISA Members will be required as part of the AFSC entry process to state the event the athlete/team earned the qualifying score(s).

Each ISA Member shall be entitled to nominate up to four (4) entrants in each Championship discipline and category who have achieved the minimum TES score for the Championship. The host ISA Member may nominate a fifth entrant in each discipline and category. Title holders may defend their titles without being counted in an ISA Member quota in any discipline and category where defence of title is permitted.

*Each ISA Member may submit a ranked reserves list of up to five (5) qualified reserves listing their highest achieved qualifying score(s) earned during the period. The athlete/team score(s) for the reserves will be ranked nationally by ISA from the scores put forward by the ISA Members. Where an ISA Member cannot fill their quota spots with eligible athletes/teams as per this communication, then eligible reserves listed athletes/teams with the next highest score(s) who are not already nominated will be given the opportunity to fill the available spots. The acceptance of any or all reserves will be based on the total quota for any category and will be advised after the close of entries.*
