General information for NON ISU CATEGORIES

Technical Panel identifies Sequences/Sections of the Pattern Dances without Key Points and evaluates up to level 1

Technical Panel identifies and calls falls.

Judges evaluate the Pattern Dance with a GOE for each sequence/section

Basic Level 1

50% of Pattern Dance is completed **75%** of Pattern Dance is completed

All skaters will skate the same steps as prescribed in the Pattern Dance Appendix.

MUSIC REQUIREMENTS FOR PATTERN DANCES

For the 2023/2024 season skaters shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances, it may be ISU Ice Dance music (tunes 1-5, excluding the last tune). According to ISU Rule 707 paragraph 6: After the completion of the last step of the Pattern Dance, the **skater** must reach the final pose within 20 seconds. If this time limit is exceeded, a "Pattern Dances Program time" deduction according to Rule 353, paragraph 1. n) shall apply.

The music must be chosen in accordance with the Rhythm of the Pattern Dance and may be vocal. The Tempo throughout the required Sequences must be constant and in accordance with the required Tempo of the Pattern Dance (see ISU Handbook Ice Dancing 2003) plus or minus 2 beats per minute (for dances with 4/4 timing) and plus or minus 3 beats per minute for waltz rhythms.

Costume Requirements

Solo Ice Dance will follow all costume rules and requirements as stated for Ice Dance in the 2023-2024 season in ISU Rule 501, para 1 - Women are permitted to wear trousers. Trousers may be any length - Accessories and props are not permitted

Solo Ice Dance events shall consist of:

Preliminary 1 Pattern Dance and Free Dance Elementary 1 Pattern Dance and Free Dance Adult Categories 1 Pattern Dance and Free Dance

All Pattern Dances must be performed with the first sequence executed in front of the judges' stand. If not, the Referee will stop the skater and instruct them to restart on the correct side without deduction. The first Step of the dance must be on beat 1 of a measure.

3. FREE DANCE REQUIREMENTS

NOTE: WITH THE EXCEPTION OF 10 SECONDS AT THE BEGINNING OF THE PROGRAM, THE MUSIC MUST HAVE AN AUDIBLE RHYTHMIC BEAT.

Music must have a change of tempo and/or expression.
