1. INTRODUCTION and PURPOSE OF THE POLICY

- 1.1 International Events in **Australia** and **New Zealand** provide an important competitive pathway for athletes to gain experience within an international context.
- 1.2 ISA athletes who have not yet achieved the required ISA International qualification score/s for International Events and ranked in the ISA International Pool may nominate for International Events in **Australia** and **New Zealand.**

2. APPLICATION OF POLICY

- 2.1 This policy applies <u>only</u> to athletes who have achieved 90% of the required ISA International qualification score/s in <u>each</u> segment in their respective discipline and category.
- 2.2 The policy applies to athletes seeking nomination <u>only</u> to International Events in Australia and New Zealand (eg. Oceania International Figure Skating Competition and Swan Trophy International).
- 2.3 Athletes seeking nomination to International Events outside of Australia and New Zealand <u>must</u> have achieved the required ISA international qualification score/s.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 Athletes <u>must</u> hold a Full Australian Passport and/or valid ISU Clearance to be an Australian representative.
- 3.2 ISU age eligible athletes in the respective discipline and category.

- 3.3 Athletes in the following figure skating disciplines: Singles, Pair Skating, and Ice Dance subject to the announcement of the event.
- 3.4 Athletes in the following categories: Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Advanced Novice, Junior, and Senior subject to the announcement of the event.
- 3.5 Athletes must submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) to the Chair, ISA High Performance at least **31** days prior to the International Event.

4. QUALIFICATION

- 4.1 Athletes <u>must</u> have achieved a minimum 90% of the required ISA International qualification score/s in <u>each segment</u> in their respective discipline and category.
- 4.2 The TES score/s in SP/PD/RD and FS/FD may be earned at different ISA Champ Series Events during the 2023/2024 and 2024/2025 seasons.
- 4.3 Athletes <u>must</u> have achieved the required qualification score for the discipline and category, **31** days prior to the International Event in Australia and New Zealand, as listed below:

5. SELECTION

- 5.1 Athletes will be selected for the nominated International Event/s based on the current ISA Season Ranking.
- 5.2 Athletes will <u>only</u> be selected to compete in <u>one</u> category in each International Event.
- 5.3 The ISA Board, at its sole discretion, will consider athletes who wish to compete one category below their current ISA category if the athlete is ISU age eligible.
- 5.4 Athletes will <u>only</u> be placed in the ISA International Pool upon achievement of the required ISA International qualification score/s for International Events outside of Australia and New Zealand.
- 5.5 Athletes should not arrange travel until the Chair, ISA High Performance and ISA Administration have confirmed selection to the International Event.
- 5.6 Under this policy, athletes will <u>only</u> be eligible to apply for ISA Members uniform.
