**Requirements:** A program consisting of 7 (seven) required elements. The sequence of the elements is optional. The skater may perform any Junior Short Program Group as listed in ISU Rule 611. The elements performed must be all from the same group, i.e. specific elements cannot be selected from multiple groups. The duration of the program is as defined in ISU Rule 502.

<b>Axel Jump</b> , Women: Double, Men: Double or Triple			
<b>Solo Jump</b> , Double or Triple <u>as prescribed in ISU group</u>			
<b>Jump combination</b> <u>as prescribed in ISU group</u> Women: Two Doubles, One Double and Triple or Two Triples Men: Double and a Triple or Two Triples			
<b>Flying Spin</b> , <u>as prescribed in ISU group</u> no change foot, no change position, min 8 revs)			
<b>Women:</b> <u>as prescribed in ISU group</u> <b>Layback or Sideways Leaning Spin or Sit or Camel spin</b> (no change of foot, no flying entry, min 8 revs), <b>Men:</b> <u>as prescribed in ISU group</u> <b>Spin in one position with change of foot</b> , Sit or Camel Spin (no flying entry, min 6 revs on each foot)			
<b>Spin combination</b> with a minimum of two (2) different basic positions and only one (1) change of foot, (no flying entry, min 6 revs on each foot)			
Women: Step sequence fully utilising the ice surface Men: Step sequence fully utilising the ice surface			
<b>Program Components Comments</b>			

The jump combination may consist of the same or another double or triple jump. However, the jumps included must be different from the solo jump.

**Repeats:** A maximum of two (2) repeats are permitted at the judges' discretion without music. The element(s) to be repeated must be from the elements already executed, either one element twice or two elements once each. No substitutions of elements are permitted from those already executed.

**Pass Mark:** The assessment will take into consideration the grade of execution of the elements and the program components in determining a Pass or Fail. Tests will be assessed in accordance with the latest ISU Communication Guidelines for marking Grade of Execution.

A Pass cannot be awarded if more than one (1) element has a GOE of -5 or more than two (2) elements have a GOE of -3 or less.
