ISA Hall of Fame Protocol

1. Introduction

Induction to the ISA Hall of Fame represents the highest level of recognition of an individual's significant contribution to Figure Skating in Australia.

Nominations may include persons who have competed at the top level in the sport or demonstrated excellence in roles supportive to the sport.

ISA acknowledges the following persons may be honoured with this esteemed accolade:

- a) Administrators
- b) Athletes
- c) Coaches
- d) Officials

2. Eligibility for Selection

In order to be selected as a member of ISA Hall of Fame, each candidate must:

- a) have made an extraordinary contribution to Figure Skating in Australia; and
- b) no longer be participating in the role for two (2) years prior to the nomination; and
- have upheld the ISU Code of Conduct and ISA Code of Ethics and Behaviour in an exemplary manner.

The nominee does not need to be a member of an ISA Member or Club at the time of nomination.

3. Nomination of Inductees

- a) The ISA Board of Directors may submit nominations.
- b) Nominations may be received from ISA Members.
- c) Nominations must be completed on the ISA Hall of Fame Nomination Form.
- d) Registrations will open on **1st October** of every year.
- e) Nominations must be submitted prior to **21**st **October** of every year.
- f) The nomination must be endorsed by the relevant ISA Member.

4. ISA Awards Committee

The ISA Awards Committee for the Hall of Fame will be selected by the ISA Board of Directors and comprise of three (3) appointed persons including one (1) independent Chair, one (1) ISA Board Director, and one (1) ISA Hall of Fame recipient.

The ISA Awards Committee will:

- a) ensure nominations have met the Selection Criteria requirements; and
- b) if required, will request additional information from the nominee; and
- c) submit recommended nominations to the ISA Board of Directors for approval prior to **1st November** of every year.

5. Induction

- a) Induction to the ISA Hall of Fame will take place at the final banquet of the Australian Figure Skating Championships (AFSC) in the year of nomination.
- b) The inductee(s) will receive a formal invitation to attend the AFSC banquet as guests of the ISA Board.
- c) The inductee(s) will be recognised with an award and inclusion in the ISA Hall of Fame honour roll.
- d) The ISA Community will receive notification of the nominated Hall of Fame inductee(s).

6. Amendment and Review

- a) The ISA Board of Directors will review the protocol annually to ensure it meets the needs of the organisation.
- b) Any amendments to the protocol will require the Boards approval.
