Revoke ISA-06(b) Policy ISA International Selection Policy for International Events in Australia and New Zealand

1. Purpose of this Communication

To advise the figure skating community that the ISA Board of Directors revoked ISA-06(b) ISA International Selection Policy for International Events in Australia and New Zealand at the ISA Board Meeting Wednesday 21 January 2025.

The ISA Board of Directors apologises for the delayed notification of this decision to members and removal of the policy from the ISA website.

2. Application of this Communication

ISA Communication 172 revokes/cancels officially ISA-06(b) ISA International Selection Policy for International Events in Australia and New Zealand effective 1 February 2025.

3. Communication Details - Combined Total Elements Score (CTES)

In place, the ISA Board of Directors approved to implement a Combined Total Elements Score (CTES) to qualify for ISA International Pools selection with an interim effective start date 1 April 2025.

The CTES is calculated by adding the Athlete/Couple's highest Technical Elements Score in the respective category for the Short Program/Pattern Dance/Rhythm Dance and the Free Skating/Free Dance. To calculate the CTES, it may be reached at the same or different ISA Champ Series Events.

The introduction of a CTES makes ISA-06(b) redundant as the implementation of the CTES will give greater opportunities for ISA Athletes to qualify for ISA International Pools and selection to ISU International Events as published on the ISU Competitions Calendar.

4. ISA Policies

The required international minimum CTES for the respective discipline and category are listed in these policies:

(a) ISA-05 ISA International Pool Qualification Policy (Junior & Senior)

(b) ISA-07 ISA International Pool Qualification Policy (Novice)
